

Guidelines for behaviour

This document was created to clarify the expected behaviour within Thalia. Keep in mind these guidelines may not encompass all possibilities. The board will assess on a case to case basis whether a member is in violation of the rules. The expectations stated in this document apply to all Thalia activities, but also outside of these when the member can be clearly associated with Thalia.

Please do address wrong behaviour from fellow Thalia members, like improper behaviour or when a member is causing a disturbance.

1 Guidelines

- While on campus, always adhere to the university's rules.
- Always follow instructions from staff such as iCIS employees or the porter. Keep in mind that we're guests in Mercator I.
- Take responsibility for cleaning up after yourself at the university. Think for example of cleaning up your mugs, tableware and the disposal of waste. When in Mercator I, follow potential instructions from the Mercator committee.
- Borrels are not allowed outside the canteens. Borrels that have been announced and approved ahead of time are exempted from this rule.
- At the Faculty of Science, alcohol consumption is prohibited before 4 PM(16:00).
- You are prohibited from using drugs at or near a Thalia event, with the exception of alcohol, nicotine and medication. If you're unsure whether a substance is considered a drug, you can ask the board.
- Drinking games are prohibited during borrels with teachers or at events where partners are present.
